OUR 2017 PETIT VERDOT COMES FROM PRITCHARD HILL, IN THE MID VALLEY ALONG THE HILLSIDE OVERLOOKING LAKE HENNESSY. THE VINEYARD IS SITUATED AT MID ELEVATION, STARTING AT 600 FEET AND RANGING TO 1200 FEET. THE SITE IS KNOWN FOR CREATING WINES THAT HAVE STRUCTURE, TEXTURE, AND ELEGANCE.

THE PETIT VERDOT IS DENSE, SPICED, SHOWS DARK FRUIT, EXOTIC SPICE, AND PRECISION IN STRUCTURE.

IN NAPA VALLEY, 2017 WAS A VINTAGE TO REMEMBER, WITH FIRES & SMOKE HITTING THE VALLEY IN OCTOBER - IN THE MIDDLE OF HARVEST. LUCKILY, OUR PETIT VERDOT WAS PICKED ON OCTOBER 7TH, MAKING IT JUST IN TIME BEFORE THE VINES COULD BE AFFECTED.

THS WINE IS DRINKING BEAUTIFULLY NOW, AND WILL CONTINUE TO DEVELOP AND EXPRESS MORE OF ITS SECONDARY NUANCES OVER THE COMING TWO DECADES.

WE TREATED THIS WINE WITH 100% NEW FRENCH OAK, AND BOTTLED IN JUNE OF 2019.
